## Introducing a Graceful Poster Image

The design for H.C.R. 2022 is a woodblock print “Unpyo” by Hiroshi Yoshida, a leading printmaker and Western-style painter of the Meiji and early Showa periods.

The work depicts the beauty of delicate light, and by overlaying the image of H.C.R. celebrating its 50th anniversary next year over Mt. Fuji floating in the sunlight amidst a sea of clouds, we presented an image of the 49th H.C.R. to be held in a graceful manner.

Name of work: Unpyo  
Printmaker: Mr. Hiroshi Yoshida

### The work described by Mr. Tsukasa Yoshida, Printmaker

Hiroshi Yoshida’s woodblock print “Unpyo” is one of the six pieces in the Japan Southern Alps Collection and is paired with “From the Summit of Komagatake,” showing a view of Mt. Fuji from the Southern Alps.

This is his representative work featuring clouds. The clouds are contrasted with Mt. Fuji, and are characterized by free and dynamic outlines and gradations of blurred prints (bokashi prints). The difference in the expression of distant clouds and nearby clouds creates a sense of perspective. This work, which was painted after a long period of seclusion in the mountains, conveys the artist’s love of nature.

His eldest son, Toshi, had difficulty walking, but Hiroshi traveled with him to the mountains and India, and later Toshi traveled and painted all over the world, including Antarctica, Africa, Europe, and Australia. Hiroshi must have had some special feelings about the future of his eldest son with disabilities.

### Profile

September 19, 1876 - April 5, 1950.

Born in Kurume City, Fukuoka Prefecture.

Leading woodblock printmaker of new woodblock prints and Western-style painter.

His sensitive, delicate, and poetic works are highly acclaimed around the world and he has many fans overseas, including Princess Diana. Last year (2021), 70 years after his death, the “Yoshida Hiroshi : Commemorating the 70th Anniversary of the Death” was held.



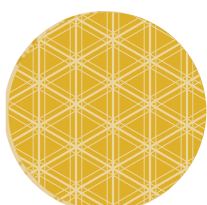
## — Venue Design —

Please look for the signboards and other signs at the venue to see which pattern you can find!



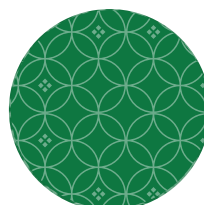
### Seigaiha (Blue ocean waves)

Waves of the ocean are patterned in the shape of a fan. It is based on the ancient Japanese court dance and music “Seigaiha,” and is depicted in “The Tale of Genji,” in which Hikaru Genji dances.



### Tsumiishi-Kikko (Piled stone-Tortoise shell)

It is believed to bring longevity and good health by protecting oneself as hard as a turtle’s shell.



### Hishi (Diamond)

This pattern is said to wish for prosperity of descendants and good health.



### Shippo (Seven Treasures)

This is an auspicious pattern that evokes the image of prosperity of descendants, good relationship, and harmony.
