# The 48th International Welfare Equipment Exhibition (H.C.R. 2021) will be held at Aomi exhibition halls

H.C.R. is one of the largest welfare equipment exhibitions in Asia where you can actually "see and touch to confirm" the products on-site. The dates and venue of H.C.R. 2021 was announced on December 1, 2020.

The venue of the 48th International Welfare Equipment Exhibition (H.C.R. 2021) will be Aomi exhibition halls for the first time due to the postponement of Tokyo Olympics and Paralympics from 2020 to 2021.

As a step toward a new "online" stage, it has been decided to continue

programs "online" as well as in 2020. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

2021 will be the 40th anniversary of International Year for Disabled Persons. H.C.R. will continue to promote the SDGs and the creation of a community-based society with the aim of "creating an affluent and inclusive society" and make further efforts in providing better service and quality of the exhibition and information on home care and welfare equipment and nursing care fields.

# Moving ahead into the New Normal era The role of welfare equipment in our lives will become even greater

We all know what a tough year 2020 has turned out to be for Japanese society due to the unprecedented COVID-19 related crisis.

In 2020, the "47th International Welfare Equipment Exhibition (H.C.R. 2020)" was unavoidably canceled due to COVID-19 outbreak. "Home and Welfare Equipment Web2020" was planned and various information were posted on the official website as the alternative "event".

Exhibitors listing and product information covers approx. 1,400 products from 355 companies. With the theme of "Social service and ICT in the age of the New Normal - beyond time and space-", webinars were online. Various other information was posted on the official site, including the release of the latest reports on the welfare field. 800,000 PVs as of December 25, 2020.

The feature of online is "available anytime and anywhere" and avoid the risk of COVID-19 infection. Some of the posted reports and webinars will be available until the end of March 2021. Other information may be available until new information about H.C.R. 2021 replaces.

According to the result of a survey we conducted in 2020 (See Page 4 and 5), it revealed that COVID-19 related crisis made a significant impact on companies and organizations who deal with home care and rehabilitation equipment and services. The top answer among the question to "What kind of impact are you having?" was "loss / decrease of opportunities due to cancellation of events such as exhibitions" (84.3%), which indicates that the impact on public relations activities and dissemination was severe.

Among the developed countries, Japan has been able to control the spread of COVID-19 in nursing care service sites with various prevention measures.

Under these circumstances, expectations for the role of home care and rehabilitation equipment are increasing and it is being actively introduced and utilized to support the independence of the elderly and disabled, reduce the burden on caregivers, and reduce or prevent the risk of infectious diseases. In the future, the development and popularization of welfare equipment will be required toward the age of living with COVID-19.

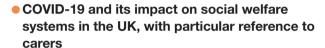

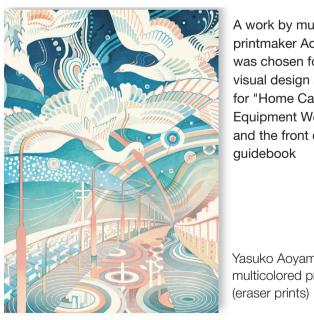

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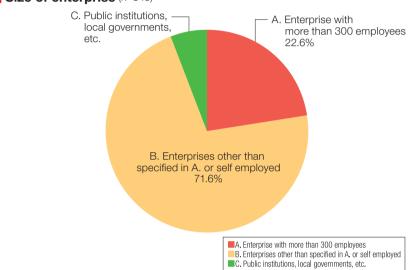

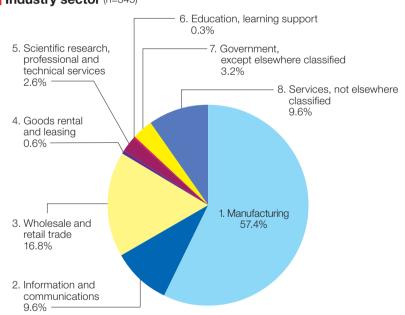

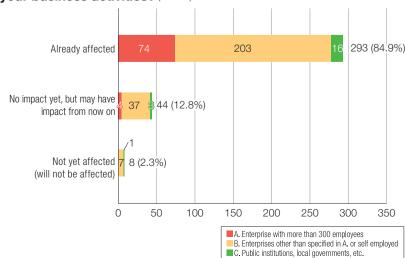
### 1 Size of enterprise (n=345)



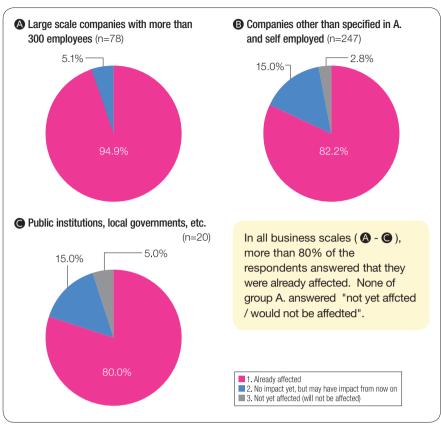
### 2 Industry sector (n=345)

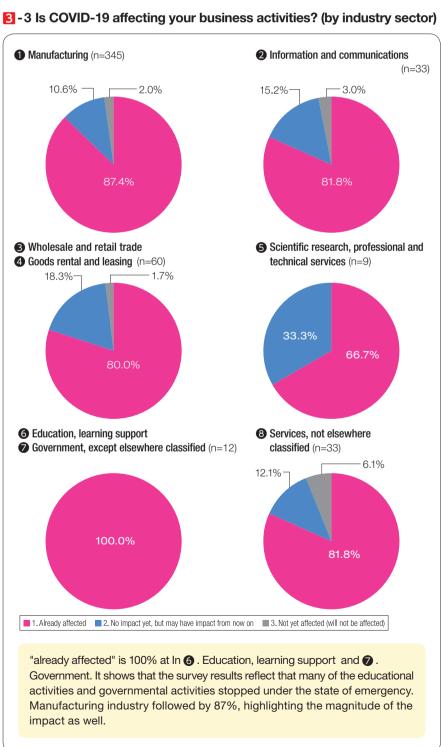


### 3-1 Impact on corporate and group activities - Is COVID-19 affecting your business activities? (n=345)

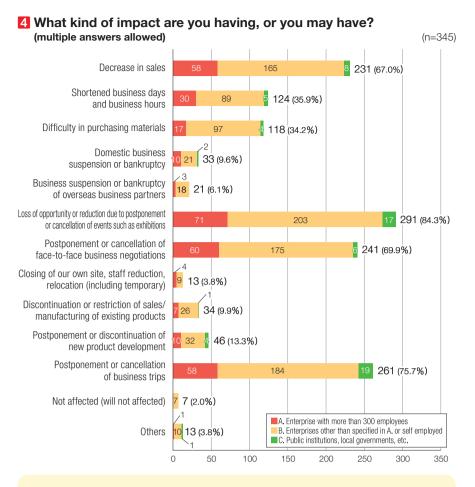


### 3-2 Impact on corporate and group activities - Is COVID-19 affecting your business activities?



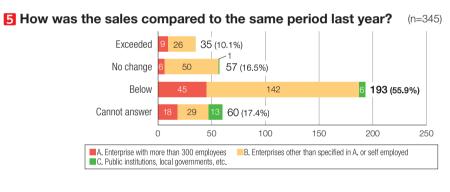


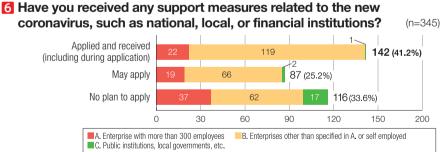

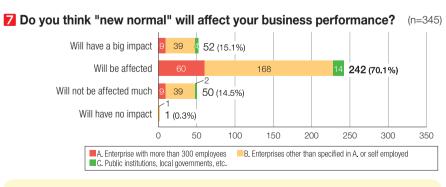


Impacts are vary but loss of opportunity due to cancellations of exhibition has come to the top at the survey.

- Loss of opportunity or reduction due to postponement or cancellation of events such as exhibitions (84.3%)
- Postponement or cancellation of business trips (75.7%)
- Postponement or cancellation of face-to-face business negotiations (69.9%)
- Decrease in sales (67.0%)



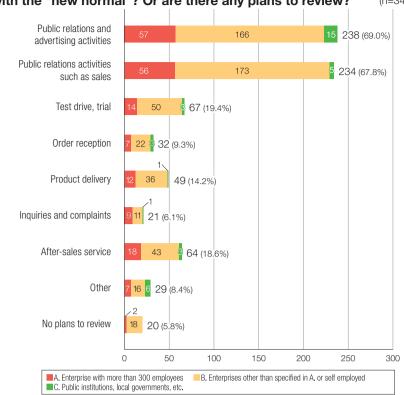




The most common answers to the question 5-7. are:

- 7 "new normal" will affect on business performance (70.1%)

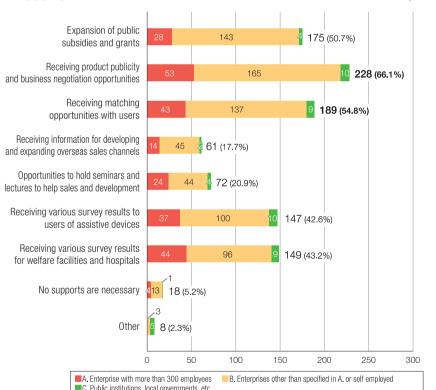
# 8 Have you reviewed the way you engage with your customers in line with the "new normal"? Or are there any plans to review? (n=345)
